## CALL TO ORDER

Warden MacInnes called the meeting to order.

## TENDERS

Tenders were received for the collection of solid waste in the northern and southern areas of Victoria County. The tenders were opened and were as follows:

It was moved by Councillor Morrison, seconded by Councillor Barron, that the tender be awarded to MacDonald's Backhoe provided they remediate the site to the satisfaction of the Department of the Environment and the Municipality. Motion carried.

It was moved by Councillor Yetman, seconded by Councillor Morrison, that Council recess for 15 minutes to allow the Environmental/Solid Waste Committee to meet on the tenders and Council then move In Camera. Motion carried.

Council returned to regular session.

## BUDGET

It was moved by Councillor Sampson, seconded by Councillor Toms, that the 2000/2001 budget be approved and the tax rates for 2000/2001 be \$1.27 residential and \$2.14 commercial. Motion carried.

The auditors are completing the year-end and it appears the deficit will be eliminated and the Municipality will end the year with a surplus. Brian Trask commended Council for their fiscal responsibility during the year.

It was moved by Councillor Sampson, seconded by Deputy Warden Yetman, that the administration and staff be commended for a job well done with regard to the Municipality's finances. Motion carried.
