

MUNICIPALITY OF THE COUNTY OF VICTORIA

STREET LIGHTING POLICY

This policy is enacted under the authority of Section 65 (n) of the *Municipal Government Act*.

This policy shall apply to the Municipality of the County of Victoria and its residents.

The Municipality of the County of Victoria is committed to the provision of municipal services that enhances the health and well being, safety and protection of persons and property. The Council is committed to the provision of street lighting in communities within the Municipality, in order to improve the safety for both pedestrian and vehicle traffic and to enhance the protection of property.

It shall be the policy of the Municipality that funding for a maximum of two (2) street lights per municipal district per year shall be allocated from the general revenues in accordance with the budgetary resources of the Municipality.

Street lights may be installed in accordance with the following criteria:

- (1) Lights must be installed only on poles already existing, within the highway right-of-way.
- (2) Installation of lights shall, if possible, be at the 100 watt low pressure sodium level or a more energy efficient light if available.
- (3) Installation of lights in a district must be approved by motion of Council.
