HEALTHY FOOD CULTURE



CBVRCE School Dietitian, Debbie Madore, is available to help navigate resources and supports in this content area.

AGRICULTURE NS

Help students learn where food comes from, the importance of agriculture, and careers available in the industry. Teachers can apply for free programs and resources that support curriculum outcomes.

CANADA'S FOOD GUIDE

Current dietary guidelines, healthy eating recommendations, recipes, plus an area to order copies of food guide.

CAPE BRETON FARMER'S MARKET

Relationships with over 50 Cape Breton vendors and skilled people that might have the expertise you are seeking

COOKING WITH KIDS

A tool from Nourish NS that lists food literacy skills (e.g. mashing, kneading) appropriate for different age groups, along with some sample recipes.

COOKSPIRATION

Recipe ideas created by Dietitians of Canada to suit preferences – from spicy, to kids' choice, to budget friendly.

DIETITIANS 4 TEACHERS

NOURISH FOOD AND FILM CHALLENGE

Students can make a short film about food based on yearly themes. Submissions due each October.

NUTRITION MONTH RESOURCES

Each March, Nourish offers a variety of tips, daily messages, recipes and activities for schools to help recognize this month.

PAN CAPE BRETON FOOD HUB

Engage in educational and social activities that build a connected community around food. Linkages to over 50 local food producers.

PLANTS TO PLATES

Incorporate food education into programs by using hand on activities for kids.

SEED LIBRARY - CAPE BRETON REGIONAL LIBRARY

Typically late March patrons can gather seed packets from self-serve stations in seven branches. Useful for schools interested in planting.

SEEDS OF DIVERSITY

Focuses on heirloom seed/endangered crop preservation. Visit resource tab for tips on seed saving, seeds starting and gardening.

SLOW COOKED DREAMS

Food-based educational and empowerment program. Created by Nadine Bernard a Mi'kmaw woman, inspired by her own experiences with poverty.
