

YARD SALE BY-LAW

SHORT TITLE

 This By-law shall be known as Yard Sale By-Law and may be cited as the Municipality of the County of Victoria Yard Sale Levy By-law.

DEFINITIONS

- In this Bylaw
 - a) "Yard sale" means a sale of surplus household goods

GENERAL PROVISIONS

3.

- a) Yard sales may only be conducted on any site between the hours of 8:00 AM and 5:00 PM and no sale may be more than three (3) consecutive days.
- b) Any posters or signs posted shall be removed at the end of the yard sale.
- c) All yard sale goods, and any apparatus facilitating the yard sale such as, but not limited to, signs, tables, chairs, or tarps for covering, shall be removed at the end of the sale

OFFENCES AND PENALTIES

4. Any person who contravenes or fails to comply with this Bylaw shall be liable to a penalty of not less than \$50 and not exceeding \$200 for the first offence and a fine of not less than \$100, and not more than \$300 for a second or subsequent offence.
